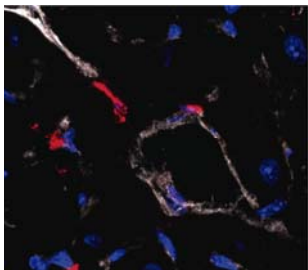


## Postdoctoral Position

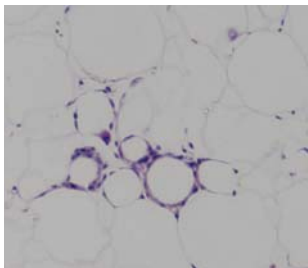

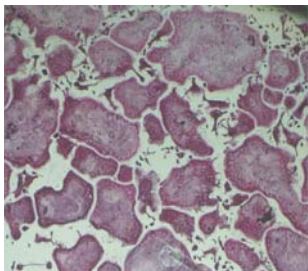
