About ICIQ

The Institute of Chemical Research of Catalonia is a dynamic and innovative research institution. ICIQ's Summer Fellowships

ICIQ offers fellowships to outstanding students with a background in Chemistry or related studies, for a period of 3 months (July, August and September 2008). The number of fellowships for 2008 is 8. Interested candidates should be in the last year of their undergraduate studies (or last year of their Master study) and be a European resident. The total amount of each fellowship is 2,000 euros.

Selected candidates will have an opportunity to work in one of the laboratories of the ICIQ for a period of 3 months. Research at ICIQ is centered on the areas of catalysis, supramolecular chemistry, and renewable energies, with special focus on sustainability problems and on nanotechnology.
