It requires a Ph.D in experimental nuclear or high energy physics with a post-doctoral experience in high energy cosmic rays experiments. Both hardware and analysis software skill is desirable. The successful candidate will be committed to undergraduate teaching and taking part to research in the area of radiodetection of high-energy cosmic rays where the Laboratory has an international recognized leading role. He will participate to exploratory runs performed by the astrophysics group in conjunction with international collaborations involved in the use of very large detection arrays.
