The research involves the study of both fundamentals and applications of laser-matter interactions at the frontier of spatial and temporal scales (nanometers & femtoseconds) and materials design (i.e advanced glasses and thin film structures) .

The successful candidate will work within the frame of projects funded by Spanish agencies as well as the Frame Program of the EU.
