The department provides a highly vibrant research environment including: particle physics, both theoretical and experimental high energy physics, nuclear physics, neuroscience, fundaments of quantum mechanics to astronomy, galactic & extra-galactic astrophysics and cosmology. More than 50 scientists work on a variety of topics (in addition to about 40 PhD students).

The initial appointment is for two years with a possible extension of another two+one years taken successful research for granted. The Universidad Autónoma de Madrid is an equal opportunity employer and welcomes applications from women, disabled persons and underrepresented minorities.

The applicant should hold a final degree in physics (M.Sc. or equivalent at their university of origin) obtained with high grades, or be able to obtain it shortly after the application deadline. Students holding a B.Sc. degree and ready to enroll in our department's official master are also eligible to apply.

Please note that due to the teaching duties the position necessitates basic knowledge of Spanish language, however, applications are open to any nationality; but if you are citizen of a country not belonging to the European Union you are not allowed to sign any contract until you obtain the compulsory documentation required to live and work in Spain (Visa, Residence Permit, Waiver of the Work Permit). Nevertheless, applicants from outside the EU or that do not speak Spanish may still send in their CV, in case another source of PhD contracts come into effect in the next months.
