







Postdoctoral position Optometry Research Group University of Valencia – Spain

The Optometry Research Group of the University of Valencia is looking for Young postdoctoral researchers.

Our group works in the design and analysis of contact and intraocular lenses, evaluates optical solutions for presbyopia and has recently opened a new research line about accommodation and emmetropization using adaptive optics. OCT and anterior segment imaging is also studied for cornea and contact-lens fitting.

The research involves the study of both fundamentals and applications of adaptive optics and wavefront aberrometry and intraocular and contact lenses design (i.e presbyopic solutions). Anterior segment technologies are used to properly analyze different corneal parameters and contact-lens fitting.

The successful candidate will work within the frame of projects funded by Frame Program of the EU (Starting Grant Project from the ERC) as well as the Spanish agencies and Industry research contracts.
