The Max-Planck-Institut für Kernphysik in Heidelberg, Germany, invites applications for several postdoc positions in theoretical particle and astroparticle physics where additional funding has recently become available. The theoretical group has a wide range of interests in several areas of physics beyond the SM, model building, dark matter, neutrinos, electroweak symmetry breaking, the physics of the early Universe, etc. Close contacts exist with the experimental groups at the institute and also with Heidelberg University. The group consists of members of the division "Particle and Astroparticle Physics" of M. Lindner, including E. Akhmedov, P. Fileviez Perez and about twenty postdocs and students, as well as the Max-Planck-Fellow group of A.Y. Smirnov and the research group of W. Rodejohann.
